My son Valen was born prematurely in 2004. He had a difficult birth and a complicated NICU stay. Subsequently, he has been diagnosed with Cerebral Palsy, more specifically a motor disability.

I then began to search for intensive, alternative therapies when I was seeing very little progress following the normal course of early intervention. I found out about HBOT and after plenty of research decided to bring Valen to the Jenny Rose Center.

I am very pleased with the progress Valen is making. His therapists are as well. We have noticed better suck-swallow-breath coordination, increased eye contact and control, better tone gains in head control and verbal skills.
